**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE A JANITORIAL CONTRACT
WITH ABLE BUILDING MAINTENANCE COMPANY FOR CITY-OWNED FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, current janitorial services for city-owned facilities are provided on a month-to-month basis and there is no contract in place;

WHEREAS, this action will reduce costs and improve efficiency through the economies of scale resulting from consolidation of services and by also creating a competitive pricing environment resulting from the bid process;

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2007 the City advertised for these services;

WHEREAS, Able Building Maintenance has submitted the lowest responsive bid;
and

WHEREAS, Able Building Maintenance was selected as a responsible bidder based on company capacity, references, and similar experience.




