**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR PROPOSITION 1B SAFETY AND
SECURITY FUNDS UP TO \$250,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSIT SYSTEM
MANAGER TO SUBMIT ALL NECESSARY PAPERWORK**

WHEREAS, the voters of the State of California passed the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality and Port Security Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 1B) to provide funding for various transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to be considered for Proposition 1B Safety and Security funding in an amount up to \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, applications for Fiscal Year 2008-09 Proposition 1B are currently being accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes:

- 1) the submittal of an application for Proposition 1B Safety and Security funds in an amount up to \$250,000; and
- 2) the Transit System Manager to submit all necessary paperwork.


