A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF MEASURES RELATED TO THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF MAYOR TO BE INCLUDED IN THE CONSOLIDATED GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 2, 2010

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2010-83 calling for, and giving notice of, a General Municipal Election to be held on November 2, 2010 and requested consolidation of the General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Municipal Election of November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also desires to submit to the voters at the election questions relating to the Elective Office of Mayor.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby orders that the following questions be submitted to the voters in the City of Elk Grove, California on Tuesday, November 2, 2010:

<u>Section 2</u>. That three (3) measures are to appear on the ballot as follows:

ELECTIVE OFFICE OF MAYOR Shall the electors elect a mayor and four city council members? A "Yes" vote means the citizens directly elect the mayor; a "No" vote	YES
continues the practice that the council chooses one of its members to preside as Mayor on an annual basis.	NO

AND

TWO YEAR TERM OF ELECTIVE OFFICE OF MAYOR Shall the term of office of mayor be two years?	YES
	NO

AND

FOUR YEAR TERM OF ELECTIVE OFFICE OF MAYOR Shall the term of office of mayor be four years?	YES
	NO

<u>Section 3</u>. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in the form and content as required by law.

<u>Section 4</u>. The polls for the election shall open at 7:00 a.m. on the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code.

<u>Section 5</u>. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

Section 6. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is hereby given and the City Clerk is hereby authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election in the time, form, and manner required by law.

<u>Section 7</u>. That the City Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Registrar of Voters.
