A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING TO ALLOW THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT TO PURCHASE 26.5 ACRES OF MITIGATION ACREAGE FROM THE DELTA BREEZE VINEYARD PROPERTY

- WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove has acquired property (known as "Delta Breeze Vineyard Property") that has been converted and managed as Swainson's Hawk foraging habitat; and
- WHEREAS, the mechanism for mitigating the loss of Swainson's Hawk foraging habitat through the Delta Breeze Vineyard Property is the payment of a mitigation fee; and
- WHEREAS, the Sacramento Regional Transit District (hereinafter referred as "RT") has the requirement to mitigate the loss of 26.5 acres of Swainson's Hawk foraging habitat associated with the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 light rail extension project (hereinafter referred as "SSCP2") that terminates at Cosumnes River College; and
- WHEREAS, RT anticipates that more than 50% of the ridership for the new extension will come from Elk Grove, and the extension of tracks to Cosumnes River College will also serve as the future extension line into Elk Grove; and
- WHEREAS, RT has consulted with the California Department of Fish and Game (hereinafter referred as "CDFG") regarding Swainson's Hawk mitigation; and
- WHEREAS, CDFG has indicated to RT that purchasing mitigation acreage at the Delta Breeze Vineyard Property would satisfy the Swainson's Hawk mitigation requirement for the SSCP2 project; and
- WHEREAS, this activity is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act. Guidelines Section 15308, Class 8, of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves allowing the Sacramento Regional Transit District to purchase 26.5 acres of mitigation acreage from the Delta Breeze Vineyard Property.
