A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE 2010 CALHOME PROGRAM (GENERAL)
APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (HCD) AND IF THE FUNDS ARE AWARDED
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A STANDARD AGREEMENT
WITH HCD AND FILE ANY RELATED DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO
PARTICIPATE IN THE CALHOME PROGRAM (GENERAL)

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove, a political subdivision of the State of California, wishes to apply for and receive an allocation of funds through the CalHome Program; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (hereinafter referred to as "HCD") has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the CalHome program established by Chapter 84, Statutes of 2000 (SB 1656 Alarcon), and codified in Chapter 6 (commencing with Section 50650) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code (the "statute"). Pursuant to the statute, HCD is authorized to approve funding allocations utilizing monies made available by the State Legislature to the CalHome program, subject to the terms and conditions of the statute and the CalHome Program Regulations adopted by HCD in April 2004; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove wishes to submit an application to obtain from HCD an allocation of CalHome funds in the amount of \$1,000,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Submits to the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) an application to participate in the CalHome Program in response to the Notice of Funding Availability issued on April 19, 2010, which will request a funding allocation for mortgage assistance for low- or very low-income first-time homebuyers in the City of Elk Grove; and
- 2) Agrees, if the application for funding is approved, to use the CalHome funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by HCD and in accordance with program regulations cited above. It also may execute any and all other instruments necessary or required by HCD for participation in the CalHome Program; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute in the name of the City of Elk Grove, the application, the Standard Agreement, and all other documents required by HCD for participation in the CalHome Program, and any amendments thereto.
