RESOLUTION NO. 2010-249

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE RECITING THE FACTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010 DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Elk Grove, California, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in the time, form and manner as provided by law; that candidates were nominated to fill the vacancy or vacancies as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects, the election was held and conducted and the ballots were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Council Resolution No. 2010-83 adopted April 27, 2010, the Sacramento County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the election and has submitted the Certificate of Facts, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

Section 3. That the number of votes given to each of the persons above named in Section 1 for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates, and for and against the measures listed in Section 2, are displayed in Exhibit A, attached.

Section 4. The City Council does declare and determine that:

- 1) Patrick A. Hume was elected from Council District 2 as a member of the City Council for the full term of four years; and
- 2) Gary Davis was elected from Council District 4 as a member of the City Council for the full term of four years.

Section 5. The City Council does declare and determine that, as a result of the election:

- A majority of the voters voting on Measure J relating to the Utility User Tax Ordinance reduction and modernization measure did vote in favor thereof; and
- 2) A majority of the voters voting on Measure K relating to the elective office of mayor **did** vote in favor thereof; and
- 3) A majority of the voters voting on Measure L relating to a two year term of elective office of mayor **did** vote in favor thereof; and
- 4) A majority of the voters voting on Measure M relating to four year term of elective office of mayor **did not** vote in favor thereof; and
- 5) A majority of the voters voting on Measure N relating to an advisory vote to consider increasing to a seven member legislative body **did not** vote in favor thereof

<u>Section 6</u>. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the Registrar of Voters and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected, the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

<u>Section 7</u>. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, a statement of the result of the election, showing: 1) the whole number of ballots cast in the City of Elk Grove, 2) the names of the persons voted for, 3) the measures voted upon, 4) for what office each person was voted for, and 5) the total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure.

Section 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.
