#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2010-268**

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING AN ADJUSTMENT TO RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE SERVICE RATES FOR 2011, 2012, AND 2013 FOR A NOT-TO-EXCEED MONTHLY INCREASE OF \$1.69 FOR EACH YEAR

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove approved a Franchise Agreement with Allied Waste Services of North America, LLC (Allied) and under the Agreement, Allied is entitled to an annual compensation adjustment; and

**WHEREAS**, increased solid waste collection and disposal service rates are necessary in order to fund:

- 1. Contractually obligated rate increases to Allied Waste; and
- Property acquisition and construction of a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility (HHWCF) consistent with the City of Elk Grove Transfer Station Master Plan.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove understands the need to adjust residential customer service rates to reflect annual changes in Allied's compensation; and

WHEREAS, by the end of 2010, the City expects to close escrow on a 21 acre site for future use by the City. This site is consistent with the Transfer Station Master Plan, and the City plans to complete the property acquisition and proceed with construction of the HHWCF; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove is in compliance with Article XIIID of the California State Constitution and the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act, the City of Elk Grove notified all affected property owners and ratepayers of the proposed solid waste rate increases and the City did not receive a majority protest; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves the rates in Exhibit A: Year 8 Solid Waste Rates of the monthly solid waste handling service charges to residents effective July 1, 2011 covering a three year period.
