

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-39**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING  
AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ELK GROVE FORD FOR  
THE PURCHASE OF FOURTEEN (14) POLICE PATROL UNITS  
IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$350,000**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains all City vehicles and procures replacements when necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Fleet division has identified fourteen (14) patrol vehicles that have reached their useful life and require replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.42, the City Council may waive the competitive bidding process when the purchase is processed through a cooperative purchasing agreement with another public agency whose procurement process is consistent with the City of Elk Grove; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of police patrol vehicles, and Hoblit Motors of Colusa met all of the criteria and was selected as the lowest responsive bidder; and


**WHEREAS**, staff approached Elk Grove Ford to match Hoblit Motors State of California's contract. Elk Grove Ford agreed and offered the same terms and conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fleet division has sufficient funding identified in its 2010-11 operating budget for this service.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby waives the competitive bidding process for a contract with Elk Grove Ford, because the price charged is comparable to the cost for using the state competitively-bid contract and because the City desires to spend locally.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager is hereby authorize to execute a contract with Elk Grove Ford for the purchase of fourteen (14) police patrol vehicles in an amount not-to-exceed \$350,000.
