WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 19.12.220 establishes a tree preservation fund, officially titled the Tree Preservation Fund; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Tree Preservation Fund is to fund tree planting efforts, tree preservation programs, and public education programs regarding trees; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Tree Foundation has presented a proposal to the City to implement native tree planting projects as part of its Native Trees in Urban and Rural Environments (NATURE) Program; and

WHEREAS, native tree planting projects are consistent with the provisions of the Tree Preservation Fund and the Greenprint program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to expend tree preservation funds for the City of Elk Grove Greenprint Program tree plantings.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to expend \$64,500 from the Tree Preservation Fund for City of Elk Grove Greenprint Program Tree Plantings.
