A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF 35 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TREATMENT CAPACITY BANK SEWER CREDITS TO THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY WATER AGENCY FOR THE PROPOSED VINEYARD WATER TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank was created by the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District in June 2000 from unused sewer capacity; and

WHEREAS, the unused sewer capacity was allocated to local jurisdictions in the form of credits to be used as an economic development tool; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento County Water Agency (SCWA) has requested the use of 35 of the City's credits for the proposed Vineyard Water Treatment Plant (the "project"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is a public improvement that will add to the quality of life for Elk Grove businesses and residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby allocates 35 Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank Sewer Credits to the Sacramento County Water Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this allocation.
