A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE **AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTENDIHE CONTRACT TERMINATION** DATE WITH REPUBLIC ELECTRIC FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO SIX MONTHS, TERMINATING NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2011 AND **INCREASING CONTRACT AUTHORIZATION BY \$151,000 WITH TOTAL CONTRACT COMPENSATION NOT-TO-EXCEED \$5,655,399** FOR A FIVE AND ONE HALF YEAR PERIOD

WHEREAS, the City currently contracts with Republic Electric for maintenance of traffic signals and street lights; and

WHEREAS, the City Council gave direction to staff to solicit a single prime contractor to execute all operations in the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, general services required by the City are to be competitively bid by the prime Public Works contractor, Willdan Engineering; and

WHEREAS, there is insufficient time for Willdan Engineering to pursue a competitive bidding process and execute contracts for public works general services prior to the expiration of the existing contract with Republic Electric which is June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the services provided by the existing contract with Republic Electric is critical to ongoing public and traffic safety and should therefore not lapse.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to extend the contract termination date with Republic Electric for a period of up to six months, terminating no later than December 31, 2011, and increasing contract authorization by \$151,000 (for the extended six month period), total compensation not-to-exceed \$5,655,399 for a five and one half year period.
