A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A FIVE YEAR MASTER AGREEMENT WITH TWO OPTIONAL ONE-YEAR EXTENSIONS WITH FUJITANI CONSULTING INC. FOR TEMPORARY STAFFING SERVICES NOT-TO-EXCEED BUDGETED AUTHORITY AND EXECUTED BY TASK ORDER ONLY


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove recognizes the need to augment regular staffing during times of peak work periods; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove recognizes the need to utilize temporary staffing for special projects or in the absence of regular staff; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove recognizes that temporary staffing is a cost effective way to augment staffing when needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the necessary documents to enter into a five year master agreement with two optional one-year extensions with Fujitani Consulting, Inc., for temporary staffing services, not-to-exceed budgeted authority and executed by task order only.
