WHEREAS, the Project provided for drainage improvements required by an agreement between the City and the property owner at 9070 Elk Grove Boulevard, dated May 4, 2005 as part of the right-of-way acquisition for the Old Town Improvements Project (2005); and

WHEREAS, Arrow Construction has completed the work in accordance with the contract documents for the Project; and

WHEREAS, if no liens or claims have been filed within 35 days of filing the Notice of Completion, the retained payment funds and any remaining amounts due will be released to Arrow Construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby accepts the Old Town Stub (9070 Elk Grove Boulevard) Drainage Improvements Project (the "Project") as complete.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Engineer to prepare a Notice of Completion and the City Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the Project with the Sacramento County Recorder.
