RESOLUTION NO. 2012-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY IN THE FORM OF LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES, LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT, AND TRANSIT BUSES

- WHEREAS, in 2003, the City of Elk Grove purchased an F350 Ambulance designated surplus by the Air Force through the Department of Defense to be converted and equipped for use by the Major Accident Investigation Team; and
- WHEREAS, in 2006 and 2007, the City of Elk Grove purchased vehicles from Elk Grove Ford and Palm Acres Auto Sales to supplement the vehicles acquired from Sacramento County upon transitioning to a City-run police department; and
- **WHEREAS**, in 2004 the City assumed responsibility for transit services from Regional Transit and began to operate *e-tran*; and
- WHEREAS, in 2005 and 2007, e-tran purchased buses from El Dorado Bus Sales and Akron (Ohio) METRO to supplement commuter routes and expand local routes; and
- WHEREAS, staff has designated three law enforcement vehicles as surplus, as they have reached the end of their service life based on years in service, mileage, and frequency / cost of repairs; four transit buses as surplus as they have reached the end of their service life based on years in service, mileage, and California Air Resources Board (CARB) control measures; and one transit bus as non-operative due to extensive rusting to the front suspension system; and
- WHEREAS, the law enforcement vehicles are equipped with emergency response equipment that shall be removed prior to public sale; and
- WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.42 specifies the terms and conditions for the disposition of surplus City property; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to surplus three law enforcement vehicles, their emergency response equipment, and five transit buses, and sell at fair market value or dispose of the assets.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the Finance Director to exercise the sale or disposal of surplus City property in the form of three law enforcement vehicles and five transit buses, including the disposal of any associated emergency response equipment through sale to other law enforcement agencies, reuse by the City, or designated as unsalvageable, based on the needs of the City. The description of these items is shown in Exhibit A to this resolution, incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proceeds from the sale or disposal of the surplus law enforcement vehicles and transit buses shall be deposited into the Facilities and Fleet Internal Services Fund and Transit Fund, respectively.
