

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-65

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE
A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH BOBO CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR
THE SPECIAL WASTE COLLECTION CENTER AND DISPOSAL LANE PROJECT
IN AN AMOUNT OF \$4,604,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER
TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$691,000**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove established the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility (HHWCF) Project to provide for proper disposal of wastes as determined by State laws; and

WHEREAS, the HHWCF has been renamed as the Special Waste Collection Center (SWCC) and Disposal Lane Project (Project) to better identify its functional scope; and

WHEREAS, the design and bidding documents have been completed and reviewed by various agencies, the City's Building and Public Works Departments and the Cosumnes Community Services District Fire Department to assure a functional and safe improvement; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2009 the City Council certified a Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR), adopted Findings of Fact and a Statement of Overriding Considerations and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) for the Transfer Station Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the work complies with the requirements of the certified Environmental Impact Report for the Transfer Station Master Plan and the Final and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program; and

WHEREAS, the total funding for the Project has been identified as \$9,787,202 from the SWCC, and Disposal Lane Projects (CIP # SW0002 and SW0003); and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2012 the City advertised for bids for construction of the SWCC and Disposal Lane; and


WHEREAS, on April 17, 2012, seven bidders submitted bids, and, after evaluation, Bobo Construction, Inc. was determined by City staff to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid as a participant in a public competitive bidding process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Rejects bids from Diede Construction Company and Menghetti Construction as non-responsive to the bidding requirements for the Special Waste Collection Center (SWCC) and Disposal Lane Project (Project); and

- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Bobo Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$4,604,000 for the base bid plus alternate #1 for the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders for the Project not-to-exceed \$691,000.
