A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION TO IMPLEMENT A STRATEGIC ENFORCEMENT INITIATIVE AS PART OF THE ORGANIZED CRIME DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE AND AMEND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S FISCAL YEAR 2011-12 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) oversees the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Forces (OCDETF), a program whose mission is to identify, disrupt, and dismantle drug trafficking and money laundering organizations through cooperative measures; and

WHEREAS, OCDETF has requested the cooperation of the Elk Grove Police Department in a strategic enforcement initiative that will require officers to work periodic overtime; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department continues to be an active partner with the DEA and other law enforcement agencies in the eradication of illegal drugs; and

WHEREAS, OCDETF has agreed to reimburse the Elk Grove Police Department up to \$15,000 for overtime hours worked by officers participating in this initiative; and

WHEREAS, this initiative supports City Council's goal to grow and support safe, livable, attractive neighborhoods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby adopts a resolution authorizing the City Manager to:

- 1) Accept program funding from the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration in the amount of \$15,000 for the purpose of implementing a strategic enforcement initiative; and
- Execute all related documents required for receiving such funds pursuant to the terms and conditions of the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration; and
- 3) Amend the Police Department's revenue and expense budget as follows:
