## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF AN AGENCY FUND AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-13 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$472,837 FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANT

WHEREAS, the Safe Routes to School Program (SRTS) is a federal program to increase the number of children who walk or bicycle to school by funding projects that remove the barriers that currently prevent them from doing so; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Unified School District (EGUSD) was awarded a non-infrastructure project grant to hire a full-time SRTS Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove is acting as a pass-through agency for this SRTS grant; and

WHEREAS, EGUSD will prepare invoices for submission to Caltrans for payment to the City of Elk Grove and the City would transfer those payments to EGUSD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the creation of an agency fund (Fund 770) and amends the Fiscal Year 2012-13 Budget for this agency fund for both revenue and expenditures in the amount of \$472,837 for the Safe Routes to School Grant.
