(CALTRANS) FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, MODERNIZATION,
IMPROVEMENT AND SERVICE ENHANCEMENT ACCOUNT (PTMISEA) FUNDS
TO REPLACE A 40-FOOT TRANSIT BUS

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove operates a comprehensive transit system; and

WHEREAS, the City has been allocated Proposition 1B Transit-Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) funding to implement and support transit capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove is authorized to request \$163,012 towards the replacement of one 40 foot transit bus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove will request allocation of the funds through the California Department of Transportation, Division of Mass Transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to have a transit fleet size needed to sustain current levels of transit service in the City to meet transit needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager to submit an allocation request for \$163,012 to the California Department of Transportation for Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) funds to replace a 40-foot transit bus.
