A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A TWO YEAR AGREEMENT WITH MOONLIGHT CLEANERS FOR DRY CLEANING SERVICE OF POLICE UNIFORMS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department has 130 sworn officer positions which mandate uniform attire; and

WHEREAS, police uniforms require dry cleaning for proper care; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department requires an average of fivehundred articles to be dry cleaned each month; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a competitive bid process to find a dry cleaning service provider that offered the most competitive prices; and

WHEREAS, Moonlight Cleaners of Elk Grove was determined to be a responsible bidder with the lowest responsive bid for the required services; and

WHEREAS, dry cleaning for police uniforms is a service budgeted every year during the citywide budget process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a two year agreement with Moonlight Cleaners for dry cleaning service of police uniforms in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.
