A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH AND WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH GRANICUS, INC. FOR STREAMING MEDIA SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS WITH ONE THREE-YEAR RENEWAL IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$211,891.

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove City Council is committed to public engagement and notice of local government affairs; and

WHEREAS, Granicus, Inc. has provided technical expertise, software, and maintenance, to webcast and archive City Council and Planning Commission meetings in order to expand and preserve the public information venue for the last eight years; and

WHEREAS, the Granicus system is a unique product that integrates with the existing Chamber facility configuration, relays information effectively to the widest audience, and provides opportunities for operational efficiency both in conduct of meetings as well as meeting preparation and post production; and

WHEREAS, supporting access to public meetings is a priority of the City Council and has been budgeted for in the Information Technology department; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code section 3.42.180(B)(3) authorizes the City Council to dispense with competitive bidding for services such as these when, in the determination of the City Council, competitive bidding is not in the best interests of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove:

- Finds that competitive bidding of the streaming media services described herein and in the proposed contract is not in the best interest of the City and hereby dispenses with and waives the competitive bidding process; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Granicus, Inc. Streaming Media Services for a period of three years, with one three-year renewal for an amount not-to-exceed \$211,891.
