

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-47**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL SOLICITATION PROCEDURE PER ELK GROVE  
MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(4) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE REQUISITION WITH ABSOLUTE  
SURVEILLANCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PORTABLE VIDEO SURVEILLANCE  
SYSTEM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$94,000**

**WHEREAS**, in August 2010, the City of Elk Grove received \$750,000 in grant funding from the Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act to establish an Emergency Operations Center (EOC); and

**WHEREAS**, staff has completed a successful retrofit of City Council Chambers, including emergency operations equipment and technology to activate a fully-functioning EOC in the event of an emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, portable video surveillance equipment is a proven emergency response solution that offers law enforcement real-time images that can be transmitted to an emergency operations center hub for analysis and planning; and


**WHEREAS**, having the ability to monitor a situation remotely would provide invaluable assistance to those responsible for critical emergency services such as evacuation, rescue, resource deployment, and traffic control; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(4) and 3.42.220 which provide an exception to the competitive bidding process when the purchase is processed through a cooperative purchasing agreement with another public agency whose procurement process is consistent with the City of Elk Grove; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process and has established a California Multiple Awards Schedule (CMAS) agreement with Absolute Surveillance for portable video surveillance systems.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby determines that compliance with the formal solicitation procedure is not in the best interest of the City and further authorizes the City Manager to execute a purchase requisition with Absolute Surveillance for the purchase of a portable video surveillance system in an amount not to exceed \$94,000.




