A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE FINDING THE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE PROJECT (WCE006) EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH TURNER SIGNS AND GRAPHICS FOR THE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE PROJECT (WCE006) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$248,026 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$21,974; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST BIDDER IF TURNER SIGNS AND GRAPHICS DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS

WHEREAS, the Wayfinding Signage Project (WCE006) (the "Project") will furnish and install 38 new wayfinding signs at various locations throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2014-19 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2014-15 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seg. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under CEQA; and

WHEREAS, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on March 11, 2015 and March 18, 2015, and bids were opened on April 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Turner Signs and Graphics was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid.

NOW; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds this project exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.

<u>Finding</u>: The proposed Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

<u>Evidence</u>: The proposed Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities). This exemption applies to the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use.

AND BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Turner Signs and Graphics for the Wayfinding Signage Project (WCE006), in the amount of \$248,026 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney:
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$21,974;
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest bidder, Frank and Son dba Express Sign and Neon, in the amount of \$255,440 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney if Turner Signs does not meet filing obligations.
