A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE 27th CYCLE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000.00

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seg. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, Household Hazardous Waste Grant program HD27 Cycle – Fiscal 2016-17 allows regional grant projects; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an Applicant's governing body to declare by Resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager to submit a regional grant application on behalf of itself as Lead Agency and the participating jurisdictions of the City of Rancho Cordova and City of Galt to the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for a Local Government Household Hazardous Waste Grant, Cycle 27. Fiscal Year 2016-2017 in the amount of \$75,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Elk Grove all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved regional grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if grant funding is awarded to the City, the City Manager is hereby authorized to amend the Integrated Waste Division's budget each fiscal year until the full grant award has been expended.
