A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SALE OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY IN THE FORM OF LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES AND LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove purchased vehicles to be utilized by the Elk Grove Police Department in the normal course of their duties; and

WHEREAS, staff has designated twelve law enforcement vehicles as surplus, as they have reached the end of their service life based on years in service and mileage or have been deemed a total loss due to collision; and

WHEREAS, the law enforcement vehicles are equipped with emergency response equipment that shall be removed prior to any public sale; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.42 specifies the terms and conditions for the disposition of surplus City property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to surplus twelve law enforcement vehicles and their emergency response equipment, and sell at fair market value or otherwise dispose of the assets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the Finance Director to exercise the sale or disposal of surplus City property in the form of twelve law enforcement vehicles, including the disposal of any associated emergency response equipment through sale to other law enforcement agencies, reuse by the City, or designated as unsalvageable, based on the needs of the City. The description of these items is shown in Exhibit A to this resolution, incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proceeds from any sale or disposal of the surplus vehicles shall be deposited into the Facilities and Fleet Internal Services Fund respectively.
