

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-123

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE FINDING THE BIG HORN/LAGUNA BUS STOP AND SIDEWALK PROJECT (WAC021) EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH FBD VANGUARD CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE BIG HORN/LAGUNA BUS STOP AND SIDEWALK PROJECT (WAC021) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,974.70; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$23,246

WHEREAS, the Big Horn/Laguna Bus Stop and Sidewalk Project (WAC021) (the "Project") will construct a six foot (6') wide sidewalk between the last driveway and Laguna Boulevard in the southbound direction of Big Horn and add a bus stop pad. The Project will also reconstruct eight (8) curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards at the Laguna Boulevard and Big Horn Boulevard intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2016-21 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under CEQA; and

WHEREAS, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on May 4, 2016 and May 11, 2016, and bids were opened on June 14, 2016; and

WHEREAS, FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds this Project exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.

Finding: The proposed Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

Evidence: The proposed Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities). This exemption applies to the minor

alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. The proposed project will consist of the following: construct a 6' wide sidewalk, bus pad, and the reconstruction of 8 curb ramps. No trees will be removed and no special circumstances exist that would create a reasonable possibility that the Project will have a significant adverse effect on the environment. Therefore, this project qualifies for the identified exemption and no further environmental review is required.

AND BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. for the Big Horn/Laguna Bus Stop and Sidewalk Project (WAC021), in the amount of \$154,974.70 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$23,246.


