A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR / CITY ENGINEER TO APPLY FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS); APPROVE AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 BUDGET AND THE 2016-2021 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PHASE IV PROJECT, CITY PROJECT NO. WTC001, STATE PROJECT CML-5479(050)

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove has undertaken the Intelligent Transportation Sytem Phase 4 Project, CIP No. WTC001 ("Project") to construct signal improvements throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received a grant for \$2,312,000 for construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the funding has been delayed by the California Transportation Commission to Federal Fiscal Year 19/20; and

WHEREAS, the California Transportation Commission (CTC) adopted Assemby Bill 3090, which allows local agencies to enter into an Advanced Funding Agreement with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and CTC to use its own funds to implement a project that has been included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and to receive a later reimbursement from STIP funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove or its authorized representative must apply for and sign documents for the Advanced Funding Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the Public Works Director / City Engineer to apply for and execute the necessary documents for an Advanced Funding Agreement Extension between the City of Elk Grove and Caltrans, all subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby amends the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget to accommodate this action; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2016-21 Capital Improvement Program be amended per Exhibit A.

Upgrade and connect 25+ traffic signals with the Traffic Management Center, Install 22 CCTV traffic monitoring cameras. Upgrade and relocate the Transportation Management Center to City Hall. Perform corridor coordination assessment studies and optimize signal timing on major corridors.

Project Location

Citywide - 22 signalized intersections on Big Horn Blvd., Bruceville Rd., East Stockton Blvd., West Stockton Blvd., Grant Line Rd., Franklin Bivd., Elk Grove Florin Rd., Laguna Bivd., Bond Rd., Elk Grove Blvd., Whitelock Pkwy., Sheldon Rd., etc. Includes 3 pedestrian crossing signals. Move Transportation Management Center from Corp Yard to City Hall.

Project Justification

The project upgrades obsolete traffic control equipment and installs ITS equipment to improve traffic flow and relieve congestion.

Grant funds (fund 351) totally \$2,312,000 in for construction were awarded in 2014 but were originally not available until Federal FFY16/17. In 2016 the CTC reprogrammed the construction grant funds to FFY19/20. In October 2016, the City sought an agreement with the CTC for advance the project with local funds and be reimbursed in FFY19/20, request is pending as of October 2016. Project revised in FY16 to include relocation of TMC to City Hall in lieu of reconfiguration upgrade at Corp Yard.

Impact if Canceled or Delayed

If the project is cancelled traffic flow will not be improved and congestion will continue.

Relationship to Other Projects
WTC005 is coordinating signals along Franklin, Bruceville and Big Horn.
