A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH PETERSON DEVELOPMENTS FOR THE OLD TOWN PLAZA RESTROOM BUILDING PROJECT (WCE021) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$236,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$23,600; AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-21 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 BUDGET BY \$35,826

WHEREAS, the Old Town Plaza Restroom Building Project (WCE021), the "Project", includes the following components: construct permanent bathroom facilities, connect power, water and sewer site utilities, construct a sidewalk connection from the public sidewalk to the restroom building, and site improvements including hardscape around the restroom; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2016-21 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as "CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2017, the City Council adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration ("MND") and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program ("MMRP") for the Project, and no further environmental review is required; and a notice of Determination under CEQA was filed with the Sacramento County Clerk/Recorder on January 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid the Project was duly advertised on February 3, 2017 and February 10, 2017 and bids were opened on February 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Peterson Developments was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and.

WHEREAS, additional funding is needed to award the project beyond the current budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Peterson Developments for the Old Town Plaza Restroom Building Project (WCE021) in the amount of \$236,000 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$23,600; and

- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with American River Construction, Inc., the second lowest responsive and responsible bidder, should Peterson Developments not meet filing obligations; and
- 4) Amends to the FY 2016-17 Capital Improvement Program and Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget for the Old Town Plaza Project (WCE021) by adding \$35,826:00 in General Fund funds.
