RESOLUTION NO. 2017-176

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING AN INCREASE TO RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE SERVICE RATES BY 3%, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2017 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 RATE YEAR 14, AND APPROVING A CONSOLIDATED SOLID WASTE ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove approved a Franchise Agreement with Allied Waste Services of North America, LLC (Allied) and under the Agreement, Allied is entitled to an annual compensation adjustment to account for increases in the costs of labor, fuel, maintenance, etc.; and

WHEREAS, increased solid waste collection and disposal service rates are necessary in order to fund contractually obligated rate increases to Allied Waste; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove understands the need to increase residential customer service rates to reflect annual changes in Allied's compensation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove has not increased Solid Waste Rates for the prior three Fiscal Years resulting in a gap between the amount customers pay and the cost to provide the service; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the proposed increase will cover a portion of the current difference between the rates paid by customers and the actual cost to provide solid waste services; and

WHEREAS, a 2016 audit of Solid Waste services recommended that the current administrative fee structure, be revised to (1) reduce the number of fees assessed; (2) ensure the fees are restricted to fund the direct and indirect costs associated with providing Solid Waste services; and (3) reflect the City's current needs; and

WHEREAS, the proposed "Solid Waste Administrative Fee" is a single fee in the amount of \$5.38 that will fund all City costs associated with providing solid waste, recycling, debt service, and household hazardous waste (HHW) services and the implementation of the requirements of the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 (AB 939), which may include but are not limited to:

- General City costs such as salaries, benefits, and department supplies;
- Administration and oversight of the Franchise Agreement and other contracts;
- Various Solid Waste programs and services intended to meet the requirements
 of AB 939 such as public education campaigns, programs targeting specific hardto-recycle or hard-to-dispose waste streams (e.g. batteries, e-waste), school
 recycling programs, and any other programs or services that enhance or
 increase residents' knowledge of or ability to reduce their waste; and
- Operational costs and debt service payments for the Special Waste Collection Center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove is in compliance with Article XIIID of the California State Constitution and the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act; the City of Elk Grove notified all affected property owners and ratepayers of the proposed solid waste rate increases and the City did not receive a majority protest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves the Solid Waste Rates and the Solid Waste Administrative Fee as shown in Exhibit A:"Year 14 Solid Waste Rates" effective September 1, 2017.

There are several commercial properties with residential characteristics for which space and access do not allow for commercial service. These properties have been "grandfathered" and thereby receive residential service and are included as part of the exclusive residential franchise. These properties are subject to the same rates and fees for basic service; however, since they are commercial in nature and therefore may generate more waste, which may have a different composition than residential waste, they are subject to different Solid Waste rates for any additional carts, as shown below.
