A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE ELK GROVE AQUATIC CENTER MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COSUMNES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove has awarded a construction contract with Arntz Builders. Inc to construct a full service aquatic center at the Civic Center, which is designed to serve competitive aquatics, instruction, water fitness, and family recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Cosumnes Community Services District provides parks and recreation services within the City of Elk Grove including the operation of two aquatic facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove and Cosumnes Community Services District desire to enter into an agreement that would benefit the community by consolidating all aquatic operations in the City under one organization and provide efficiencies for management, staffing, scheduling, and public outreach; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove and Cosumnes Community Services District have developed a Management and Operational Agreement under which the City will maintain ownership of the Aquatic Center and contribute financially to its operation, and the Cosumnes Community Services District will operate and maintain the Aquatic Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Elk Grove Aquatic Center Management and Operational Agreement with the Cosumnes Community Services District in substantially the form presented to the City Council.
