A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE 3.42 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT CHAPLAINCY SACRAMENTO FOR CRISIS RESPONSE SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000 ANNUALLY THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023 FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$180,000

WHEREAS, law enforcement personnel face difficult, life-threatening events as a part of their job; and

WHEREAS, members of the community may, at times, face serious, life-altering events; and

WHEREAS, Law Enforcement Chaplaincy Sacramento has been a trusted partner, providing crisis response services to the City of Elk Grove for many years; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement crisis response chaplaincy is a unique service only offered in the Sacramento region by Law Enforcement Chaplaincy Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interested of the City to proceed with securing an agreement with Law Enforcement Chaplaincy Sacramento and dispense with the competitive bidding process as allowed by City of Elk Grove Municipal Code 3.42.140 (B)(2).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the competitive bidding process pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code 3.42 and authorizes the City Manager to execute a Second Amendment to the contract with Law Enforcement Chaplaincy Sacramento, in substantially the form presented, for crisis response services in the amount of \$20,000 annually through June 30, 2023 for a total contract not-to-exceed amount of \$180,000.
