## **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-249**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE MOBILE LICENSE PLATE READER CAMERA SYSTEMS WITH INTEGRATED PROCESSOR, MOUNTING BRACKET, AND SYSTEM START-UP FOR A TOTAL COST NOT-TO-EXCEED \$56,899

WHEREAS, the use of Mobile License Plate Readers (LPR) has been a part of the Elk Grove Police Department since 2008; and

WHEREAS, License Plate Readers electronically scan hundreds of license plates per hour within a certain radius and determine if a link exists between a plate that has been read and a reported crime; and

**WHEREAS**, the LPRs currently in use by the Elk Grove Police Department are manufactured by Vigilant Solutions; and

WHEREAS, the new LPR units will replace three outdated systems and will become a part of the overall suite of products and services offered by Vigilant Solutions currently in use by the Elk Grove Police Department; and

WHEREAS, additional License Plate Readers from Vigilant Solutions will also create interoperability and interface compatibility among LPR units and ensure the Elk Grove Police Department can run one coordinated system for all License Plate Readers; and

**WHEREAS**, for the reasons presented, pursuit of competitive bidding for the purchase of three Mobile License Plate Readers is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with competitive bidding for the proposed License Plate Reader purchase and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract for the purchase of three Mobile License Plate Reader camera systems with integrated processor, mounting bracket, and system start-up for a total cost not-to-exceed \$56,899.
