WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department retained Howell Consulting, an emergency management consultant to assist with the 2018 update of the City's Emergency Operations Plan to ensure compliance with state and federal guidelines; and

WHEREAS, updating the City's Emergency Operations Plan is consistent with City Council's goal of continuing to foster and support the safest neighborhoods, promote the unique attributes of Elk Grove communities and lifestyles - both urban and rural – and connect neighborhoods internally and to the region through roads, transit, and trail.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves the 2018 Emergency Operations Plan Update for the City of Elk Grove and Letter of Promulgation supporting emergency preparedness.
