RESOLUTION NO. 2019-067

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE 2019 LAGUNA RIDGE SPECIFIC PLAN SUPPLEMENTAL PARK FEE PROGRAM NEXUS STUDY UPDATE AND ESTABLISHING THE LAGUNA RIDGE SPECIFIC PLAN SUPPLEMENTAL PARK FEE PROGRAM FEES (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove General Plan includes a general description of the location, capacity, and types of facilities needed to serve new development in the City; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community and to ensure that adequate park and other recreational facilities are provided for the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan, and so that new development in the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan pays its fair share of the cost of providing these facilities, the levy of updated park facilities fees is necessary, and

WHEREAS. Chapter 16.82.070 of the Elk Grove Municipal Code describes the City's program for funding park land and park facilities for the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan from development impact fees (the "Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program"), makes administrative provisions for the implementation of the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program, and provides that the individual fees included within the program may be periodically amended by resolution (in addition to automatic adjustments based on cost indices), and

WHEREAS. Goodwin Consulting has prepared for the City a 2019 Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program Nexus Study Update dated March 12. 2019. ("Nexus Study Update") which details the relationship between the use of and need for the proposed fees and the types of development on which the fees are imposed, the relationship between the amount of the fees and cost of the public facilities and their associated park land acquisition, which has been presented to the City Council and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Mitigation Fee Act (Government Code Section 66000 et seq.) at least one open and public hearing was held on the adoption of the Nexus Study, at which written and oral presentations were made as part of a regularly scheduled City Council meeting. The date, time and place for the public hearing(s) was duly noticed in accordance with Government Code Sections 66018 and 6062a. A draft Nexus Study was made available for public inspection for a period of at least ten (10) days prior to said public hearing. Background data and materials referenced therein was made available to interested parties upon request to the City Clerk's Office at least ten (10) days prior to the date of said hearing. Following receipt of written and/or oral comments from interested persons on the Nexus Study, the City Council closed the public hearing on the Nexus Study, and provided direction to City Staff concerning the Nexus Study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1. Incorporation of the Nexus Study: This Resolution adopts the City of Elk Grove 2019 Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program Nexus Study Update, dated March 12, 2019 (the "Nexus Study"), and presented with the accompanying staff report. The Nexus Study, along with the studies and reports it may reference or be based upon in whole or in part, and together with any amendments thereto and any supplemental or implementation actions pursuant thereto made after its initial adoption, update and re-establish the need, costs and financing of certain park facilities and park land acquisition arising out of development in the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan, and present a reasonable basis on which to update the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program (Program) fees under this Resolution. The Nexus Study establishes the reasonable relationship between the need for the public facilities and the impacts of the various types of new development identified, for which the corresponding Program fee is to be charged.
- 2. Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program: The Program fees, imposed pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code (EGMC) Chapter 16.82, are hereby established at the levels set forth in the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program Nexus Study Update dated March 12, 2019. The applicable Program rates by land use category are shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program Administrative Fee: The Program Administrative Fee is intended to off-set the actual reasonable costs for the collection, deposit investment, accounting, updating, analysis, and reporting for the Program. The Program Administrative Fee, imposed pursuant to EGMC Chapter 16.82, is hereby established at the level set forth in the Laguna Ridge Specific Plan Supplemental Park Fee Program Nexus Study Update dated March 12, 2019, as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The Program Administrative Fee is the same for all land use categories described in the Nexus Study Update.
- Adjustments: The Program fees shall be adjusted pursuant to the guidelines prescribed in EGMC Chapter 16.82, or as may be amended during the duration of the Nexus Study
- 5. Construction of Resolution: The provisions of this Resolution are subject and subordinate to the provisions of EGMC Chapter 16.82 and shall at all times be construed and applied consistent therewith as the same presently exists or as may from time to time hereafter be amended.
- **6.** Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective June 10, 2019, which is greater than 60 days after its adoption.
