## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-110**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE "CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND BAGLEY ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR THE SALE OF GOODS AND SERVICES" (C-14-556) TO INCREASE THE TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT BY \$3,750 TO \$82,578.39 AND TO EXERCISE THE OPTIONAL ONE-YEAR EXTENSION

- **WHEREAS**, the City contracted with Bagley Enterprises, Inc. ("Bagley") in 2014 for the purchase and installation of an aerosol can crusher (C-14-556); and
- **WHEREAS**, the installation of the aerosol can crusher will require certification by Underwriters Laboratories ("UL"); and
- **WHEREAS**, the contract was amended in 2016 to add additional budget for the cost to obtain the UL Certification and a follow-up field evaluation (C-16-090); and
- **WHEREAS**, the initial field evaluation by UL indicated that additional corrective actions would be required before certification could be issued for the aerosol can crusher; and
- **WHEREAS**, the current contract authority is insufficient as the additional costs associated with the required corrective actions and a second UL field evaluation were not fully anticipated in the budget amount added as part of the First Amendment (C-16-090); and
- WHEREAS, Bagley has already completed most of the scope of work to install the can crusher machine and the existing contract includes the remaining work to be completed therefore, it would be most efficient to forgo a formal bid process for the completion of this work and to engage the services of Bagley to complete the project; and
- **WHEREAS**, for the reasons presented, a formal proposal process will not be in the best interest of the City due to the additional expenditure of time and money that is not likely to result in an outcome more advantageous to the City.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal proposal procedures pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute the second amendment to the "Contract Between the City of Elk Grove and Bagley Enterprises, Inc. for the Sale of Goods and Services" in substantially the form presented to increase the total contract amount by \$3,750 for a total not to exceed \$82,578.39 and to exercise the optional one-year extension.
