**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2019-145 AND APPROVING THE SENATE BILL 1
STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROJECT LIST FOR THE FY 2019-20 FUNDING
ALLOCATION, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR AUTHORIZED
DESIGNEE, TO MAKE ANY NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS, AMENDMENTS, OR
REVISIONS TO TRANSIT'S FISCAL YEAR OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS
TO ACCOMMODATE THE FY 2019-20 SGR PROGRAM FUNDING**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, establishes the State of Good Repair (SGR) program to fund eligible transit maintenance, rehabilitation and capital project activities that maintain the public transit system in a state of good repair; and

WHEREAS, SGR funds are allocated by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG); and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's share of SGR program funds for Fiscal Year 2019-20 was revised from \$249,529 to \$259,558; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2019-145 is being rescinded in order to correct the fiscal year reference to FY 2019-20 SGR program funds and the allocated funding amount being considered for the public record; and

WHEREAS, these SGR program funds will be used for the project identified in Exhibit A of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify for these funds, the City of Elk Grove is required to submit a proposed project list to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized to submit a request for the scheduled allocation of the SB 1 State of Good Repair program funds, and to execute the related grant applications, forms, and agreements, and any amendments thereto.

WHEREAS, the City agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances document and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all SGR funded transit capital projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2019-145 and approves the SB 1 State of Good Repair Project List, as identified in Exhibit A, for the FY 2019-20 funding allocation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager, or his/her designee, to make any necessary adjustments, amendments, or revisions to Transit's fiscal year operating and capital budgets to accommodate the FY 2019-20 SGR program funding.
