**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT DOMESTIC CANNABIS
ERADICATION / SUPPRESSION PROGRAM (DCESP) GRANT FUNDING FROM
THE US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION TO
IMPLEMENT A STRATEGIC ENFORCEMENT INITIATIVE FOR MARIJUANA
ERADICATION AND AMENDING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$25,000**

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department has investigated and eradicated hundreds of large indoor marijuana locations in and around Elk Grove since 2010; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration provides a funding opportunity to assist local law enforcement agencies with marijuana eradication efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department submitted a successful grant application in the amount of \$25,000 which will assist in investigating and eradicating illegal drug operations in the City of Elk Grove; and


WHEREAS, these grant funds will provide funding for officers to work overtime to investigate illegal drug operations in the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, this grant supports City Council's goal to foster and support the safest neighborhoods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to:

- 1) Accept DCESP grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration in the amount of \$25,000 for the purpose of eradicating marijuana cultivation in the City of Elk Grove; and
- 2) Execute all related documents required for receiving such funds pursuant to the terms and conditions of the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration; and
- 3) Amend the Police Department's revenue and expense budget each fiscal year in the total amount of \$25,000 until all funds are expended; and
- 4) Authorizing the City Manager to execute all future agreements and related documents with the U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration for additional DCESP grant funding.




