5. REGULAR AGENDA ACTION ITEMS

5.1. Receive information from Historian Adeyinka Maddy regarding ideas on creating a Youth Commission timeline.

Historian Adeyinka Maddy proposed a possible timeline to the commission. The timeline was presented on a Prezi presentation and outlined what it could look like. The first page had an option to choose an event. When he clicked on an event, it takes you to another slide with more information about what happened at the event and the purpose of it.
