### Redistricting Background

- California Elections Code section 21600 requires all cities to redistrict after each Federal decennial census as a basis so that the districts shall be as nearly equal in population as may be possible
- Data from the 2020 Census became available in September 2021.
- City last conducted redistricting based on the 2010 Census through a process conducted April – June of 2011.
- State redistricting process requirements updated since last effort

### Request for Proposals Process and Vendor Engagement

- Request for Proposals issued November 5, 2021 (and closed 12-03-21)
   with one response from Redistricting Insights
- After publication of the 01-12-22 agenda, Redistricting Insights informed the City they would not be able to service the contract
- Staff have engaged discussion with National Demographics Corporation (NDC)

## Proposed Work Model

- City staff will work in conjunction with NDC for presentation of parameters and requirements for redistricting, NDC will provide demographic analysis of maps.
- City staff will initiate community outreach, workshop opportunities, and presentation engagements (presenting to groups on request a redistricting overview and methods to participate and submit maps)
- Community outreach a combination of teleconference and in-person workshop opportunities
- Targeted outreach would commence mid-January, establish schedules for engagement throughout February, and staff would provide outreach updates at the regular meetings of February 9, February 23, and March 9.
