RESOLUTION NO. 2017-081

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ESTABLISHING A FRANCHISE FEE AMOUNT FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE SERVICES TO INCLUDE A MONETARY COMPONENT AND A SERVICE COMPONENT

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove ("City") adopted Resolution No. 2007-149, which set the current franchise fee amount of 10% of gross receipts for residential solid waste services; and

WHEREAS, the City's franchised residential solid waste hauler also provides specific citywide services at no additional charge to the City or to City residents receiving and paying for solid waste services; and

WHEREAS, these services are provided in a manner similar to the payment of franchise fees in that they are provided in exchange for the granting of an exclusive franchise agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove ("City Council") intends to clearly delineate that these services are included as part of the franchise fee; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2007-149 shall remain in effect through June 30, 2018 and this resolution shall become effective on July 1, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby establishes a Franchise Fee for Solid Waste services, effective July 1, 2018, comprised of the following:

- Monetary payment equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the total gross receipts billed by the franchised hauler to all customers receiving residential curbside solid waste services;
- Solid Waste and recycling services for up to eight (8) annual Code Enforcement community clean-up projects;
- Solid waste and recycling services at up to twenty five (25) City-designated special events per year;
- The collection and proper disposal of solid waste that is illegally dumped;
- The annual provision of three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each to graduating local high school seniors who intend to study environmental science or a related field;
- Collection and disposal of up to three hundred fifty (350) deceased nondomesticated animals per year weighing less than one hundred fifty (150) pounds each;
- The organization of and provision of solid waste and recycling services for four (4) annual clean-up events (e.g. neighborhood, park, or creek clean-up events);
- Solid waste and recycling Service at all City owned facilities;

- Alternative service location (i.e. "roll-out service") for seniors and disabled customers;
- Solid waste and recycling service at all trash and recycling cans located in Old Town Elk Grove and at City-owned bus stops.
- Provide compost to the Elk Grove Community Garden located at 10025 Hampton Oak Drive up to one hundred (100) cubic yards per contract year without charge.
