A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MASTER SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH ENFORCEMENT VIDEO, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE IN-CAR AND BODY-WORN CAMERAS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$600,000 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020

- **WHEREAS**, the Elk Grove Police Department currently has 135 sworn positions; and
- **WHEREAS**, police in-car cameras have been a part of the Elk Grove Police Department since 2008, and body-worn cameras since 2015; and
- WHEREAS, in-car and body-worn cameras provide law enforcement an additional layer of safety and documentation for events, actions, and conditions during critical incidents and contact with the public; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Department conducted research and a trial of the country's leading law enforcement in-car and body-worn camera manufacturers in an effort to find the most reliable, advanced technology in the field; and
- **WHEREAS**, Enforcement Video, LLC manufactures WatchGuard video products and those products have been found to be superior to others tested by EGPD; and
- WHEREAS, EGPD has been using WatchGuard video products exclusively since 2008; and
- WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, compliance with the formal bidding procedures is not in the best interest of the City for the purchase of the subject equipment, and dispensing with formal bidding is appropriate; and
- WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a Master Service Agreement with Enforcement Video, LLC for the purchase of in-car and body-worn cameras, including replacement equipment and related components, as needed through December 31, 2020.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with competitive bidding pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute a Master Service Agreement with Enforcement Video, LLC for the purchase of police in-car and bodyworn cameras in an amount not to exceed \$600,000 through December 31, 2020.
