

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-166

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE FINDING NO FURTHER ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW IS REQUIRED FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO STATE CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15183, 15301, AND 15303; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MASTER LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH CROWN CASTLE FIBER, LLC FOR SMALL CELL WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES

WHEREAS, Crown Castle Fiber, LLC seeks approval of a first amendment to the master license agreement (MLA) for small cell wireless communications facilities (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project will remove four and add seven new small cell facility locations listed in Exhibit A to the Amended MLA; and

WHEREAS, the Project will add usage of Zone 2 Electrolier (Dual Arm) and Common Type Electrolier (Series B) pole designs; and

WHEREAS, the pole designs have been verified by staff to be in compliance with the City's Standard Construction Specifications, Standard Drawings, and Elk Grove Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Project qualifies as a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resource code §§21000 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Project is exempt from environmental review under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15183, 15301, and 15303.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds no further environmental review is required under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the Project pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15183, 15301, and 15303.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the First Amendment to the Master License Agreement with Crown Castle Fiber LLC, in substantially the form presented, for small cell wireless communications facilities.
