ORDINANCE NO. 1-2006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE REPEALING CHAPTERS 16.82, 16.85, and 16.87 OF THE ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT FEES

The City Council of the City of Elk Grove does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY.

The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal several chapters of the Elk Grove Municipal Code relating to development impact fees established by the County of Sacramento that have been superseded by other City fee programs, namely Chapter 16.82, which relates to fees for public facilities for Elk Grove/West Vineyard, Chapter 16.85, which relates to Laguna area roadway fees, and Chapter 16.87, which relates to roadway and transit fees. The City Council enacts this ordinance pursuant to the authority granted cities by Article XI, Section 7 of the California Constitution.

SECTION 2. REPEAL.

Chapter 16.82 "Establishment of Development Fees to Finance the Cost of Public Facilities Within the Elk Grove/West Vineyard Public Facilities Plan Area," Chapter 16.85 "Laguna Area Roadway Fee," and Chapter 16.87 "Roadway and Transit Development Fees" of the Elk Grove Municipal Code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. In lieu of publication of the full text of the ordinance within 15 days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance may be published at least five days prior to and fifteen (15) days after adoption by the City Council and a certified copy shall be posted in the office of the City Clerk, pursuant to Government Code section 36933(c)(1).
