ORDINANCE NO. 18-2007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AMENDING THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ZONING MAP FROM AR-5 TO AR-2 FOR THE RICHERT PARCEL MAP PROJECT NO. EG-06-1150 APN: 123-0190-053

The City Council of the City of Elk Grove does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Purpose and Authority

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the City of Elk Grove Zoning Map as shown on attached Exhibit A.

Section 2: Findings

Rezone

<u>Finding</u>: The proposed rezoning is consistent with the General Plan goals, policies, and implementation programs.

<u>Evidence</u>: The General Plan identifies this area of Elk Grove as rural in character and designates the property as Rural Residential. This General Plan Land Use Category requires a minimum parcel size of two acres and a maximum size of 10 acres. The existing parcel is 5-acres gross and the proposed parcels are both 2.5-acres gross. The proposed zoning for the new parcels of AR-2 and the size of the propose parcels are within the density and minimum lot size for the General Plan land use designation for this property. Therefore, the proposed project is consistent with the General Plan.

<u>Finding</u>: The proposed rezone is in the public interest (Section 65358(a) of the Government Code).

<u>Evidence</u>: The Applicant's proposal is consistent with the allowed density ranges and uses in the Elk Grove General Plan, General Plan Land Use Map, and East Elk Grove Specific Plan. The proposed rezoning meets all applicable standards of the Elk Grove Zoning Code. The proposed project implements the General Plan's objectives for orderly and systematic development and responds to opportunities and constraints in the local community area.

Section 3: Action

The City Council hereby amends the City of Elk Grove Zoning Map for APNs 127-0140-007 and 127-0140-029 as shown on attached Exhibit A subject to the findings contained in this Ordinance.

Section 4: No Mandatory Duty of Care.

This ordinance is not intended to and shall not be construed or given effect in a manner that imposes upon the City or any officer or employee thereof a mandatory duty of care towards persons and property within or without the City, so as to provide a basis of civil liability for damages, except as otherwise imposed by law.

Section 5: Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable. This City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any particular portion thereof and intends that the invalid portions should be severed and the balance of the ordinance be enforced.

Section 6: Effective Date and Publication

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. In lieu of publication of the full text of the ordinance within 15 days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance may be published at least five days prior to and fifteen (15) days after adoption by the City Council and a certified copy shall be posted in the office of the City Clerk, pursuant to GC 36933(c)(1).


