ORDINANCE NO. 24-2007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT ON VARIOUS ROADWAY SEGMENTS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE, CALIFORNIA does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS.

On July 11, 2007, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove reviewed and considered the engineering and traffic surveys and related information, attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Based upon the review of the Survey and related information, the City Council finds the prevailing or 85th percentile speeds of the vehicles are:

Calvine Road – Bradshaw Road to Vineyard Road Waterman Road – Rancho Drive to Mainline Drive/Dino Drive Civic Center Drive – Bruceville Road to Elk Grove Boulevard Whitelock Parkway – Bruceville Road to Franklin Boulevard Franklin High Road – Whitelock Parkway to Whitelock	53 miles per hour 51 miles per hour 38 miles per hour 42 miles per hour 37 miles per hour
Parkway West Stockton Boulevard – Laguna Boulevard to Lewis Stein Road	38 miles per hour
Stonebrook Drive – East Park Drive to Winding River Way West Lake Drive – Elberon Way to Nolan Street	31 miles per hour 36 miles per hour

Based on the review of the Surveys, the City Council finds that the most appropriate speed limit to facilitate the orderly movement of traffic that is reasonable and safe for the above-listed streets is as set forth in Section 2.

SECTION 2. <u>DECLARATION OF SPEED LIMITS</u>.

Based on findings set forth in Section 1, above, the City Council hereby declares the following speed limits:

Calvine Road between Bradshaw Road and Vineyard Road shall be fifty-five (55) miles per hour;

- Waterman Road between Rancho Drive and Mainline Drive/Dino Drive shall be fifty (50) miles per hour;
- Civic Center Drive between Bruceville Road and Elk Grove Boulevard shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour;
- Whitelock Parkway between Bruceville Road and Franklin Boulevard shall be forty (40) miles per hour;
- Franklin High Road between Whitelock Parkway and Whitelock Parkway shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour;
- West Stockton Boulevard between Laguna Boulevard and Lewis Stein Road shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour;
- Stonebrook Drive between East Park Drive and Winding River Way shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour; and
- West Lake Drive between Elberon Way and Nolan Street shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

SECTION 3. DIRECTION TO CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER.

On or after the effective date of this ordinance, the City Engineer is directed to clearly post speed limit signs effectuating Section 2, above, to give notice that this ordinance is in effect.

SECTION 4. NO MANDATORY DUTY OF CARE.

This ordinance is not intended to and shall not be construed or given effect in a manner that imposes upon the City or any officer or employee thereof a mandatory duty of care towards persons and property within or without the City, so as to provide a basis of civil liability for damages, except as otherwise imposed by law.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable. This City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any particular portion thereof and intends that the invalid portions should be severed and the balance of the ordinance be enforced.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. In lieu of publication of the full text of the ordinance within fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance may be published at least fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance may be published at least five days prior to and fifteen (15) days after adoption by the City Council and a certified copy shall be posted in the office of the City Clerk, pursuant to GC 36933(c)(1).
