A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
RELATIVE TO PROVISION OF TRAFFIC LAW ENFORCEMENT
BY THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol provides traffic law enforcement services within the unincorporated area of Sacramento County; and

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol, upon the request of the governing body of a newly incorporated city, will continue to provide such traffic law enforcement services without reimbursement during the remainder of the fiscal year of incorporation, or until the establishment of a police department, whichever occurs first;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, that it does hereby request the California Highway Patrol to continue to provide traffic law enforcement services within the City in accordance with the California Highway Patrol policy at the same level of service previously provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby directed to forward this request to the California Highway Patrol Area Commander for the South District of Sacramento.


