New Grant Supports Safe Streets and Roads for All

I am pleased to report that the City has been awarded a \$680,000 Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant from Caltrans to develop a comprehensive plan to collect and analyze traffic safety data and conduct community outreach to improve local traffic safety. Having a comprehensive plan will put the city in a good position for future funding opportunities to implement and construct safety-related projects. Many thanks to our Public Works and Strategic Planning teams for their work on this project.

Enhanced Winter Sanctuary Now Open

The Enhanced Winter Sanctuary opened November 1 and there were 21 people staying at the facility as of November 6, including many individuals who have a long history of homelessness in Elk Grove. Our homeless outreach navigator continues to be the contact for referrals. Interested individuals may call 916-588-0304 to request information and a shelter assessment.

Veterans Day Parade Returns

Elk Grove American Legion Post 233 will host the Veterans' Day Parade this Saturday, November 11 starting from the Cosumnes CSD Administrative Building (8820 Elk Grove Boulevard) at 11:11 a.m. and concluding at Elk Grove Regional Park. Card kits are available while supplies last. There's a limit of five kits per family.

Influence Our Future at the Climate Compass Workshop

The City is updating its 2019 Climate Action Plan (CAP), called the Climate Compass, to provide a framework for mitigating the impacts of climate change. Staff will host a virtual workshop next Wednesday, November 15, at 6 p.m. to connect with the community and look at Elk Grove's greenhouse gas inventory, explore key climate hazards impacting the city and help identify our vulnerabilities and strengths.
