STORMWATER QUALITY CONCEPTUAL PLAN REQUIREMENTS

<u>Objective of the Stormwater Quality Conceptual Plan</u>: To demonstrate that conceptually, the applicant has adequately incorporated suitable stormwater quality control measure(s) into the design of the proposed project, in accordance with City of Elk Grove stormwater ordinances, improvement standards, the municipal stormwater quality permit, and all applicable state and federal stormwater quality regulations, prior to the issuing of development conditions.

<u>Submittal Requirements</u>: All new development and significant redevelopment projects falling within the priority project categories as defined in the Development Standards Plan, approved by the Regional Water Quality Control Board in May, 2005; are required to implement stormwater quality control measure(s) to reduce pollutant discharges. The applicant shall submit a Stormwater Quality Conceptual Plan that demonstrates how the proposed project will utilize acceptable control measures to be compliant with all applicable ordinances, standards, permits and regulations. Acceptable control measures and priority project categories are listed in the "Selection Matrix for Priority Project Categories" provided in the supplemental package of this application. The conceptual plan can be submitted as text or in text/graphic format.
