

- Living document




ELK GROVE'S GENERAL PLAN






WHY UPDATE THE GENERAL PLAN?

- Improved bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure that is safer and better connected




500+ individuals and families participated in 4 Mobile Workshops from September 30, 2015 – December 12, 2015



VISIONING WORKSHOP

In the small group activities, participants desired:

- Alleviated traffic congestion
- Complete streets
- Improved bicycle infrastructure and connections to the trail system
- City-sponsored cyclovia (street closure) events
- Light rail connecting to other cities
- Expanded E-tran reach/schedule
- Electric car charging stations



25+ individuals participated in the Visioning Workshop on November 7, 2015.

OTHER NOTABLE COMMENTS

- Improve E-tran service: better connections between busses and trains, more weekend service
- Need a way for the disabled and others who cannot drive to get to job centers outside of Elk Grove
- Traffic needs to be alleviated, especially around schools and major highways
- Consider bus rapid transit on major corridors
- Connect our off-street trail system with the on-street pedestrian and bicycle system
- Transit is important for air quality and economic development




MOST COMMON DESTINATIONS IN ELK GROVE
