

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE STATE SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FUND TO BE USED FOR FRONTLINE POLICE OPERATIONS AND SERVICES FOR A TWO-YEAR PERIOD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$258,675 AND TO INCREASE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S REVENUE AND EXPENSE BUDGET BY \$258,675

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has recently authorized the release of supplemental funding for frontline law enforcement under the State Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (SLESF) for FY 2016/2017; and

WHEREAS, the amount appropriated for the Elk Grove Police Department is \$258,675 for a two year period; and

WHEREAS, funds under this program must be used in accordance with Government Code 30061; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has determined an expenditure plan that supports police operations and services for the City of Elk Grove; and

WHEREAS, the SLESF fund requires the Police Department's expenditure plan under this program be approved by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to: 1) accept an appropriation from the State Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (SLESF) in the amount of \$258,675; 2) increase the Police Department's revenue and expense budget in the amount of \$258,675; and 3) expend funds in accordance with Government code Section 30061 mandating these funds be used for frontline police operations and services for a two-year period.




