

PUBLIC COMMENT PROCEDURES DURING COVID-19 CLOSURE

Consistent with Executive Orders issued by the Governor of the State of California, City Council meetings are being conducted by teleconference only. The meeting location will be the City Council Chamber, but it will not be open to the public.

Members of the public who wish to provide public comment, either for matters not on the agenda or on a particular matter, are encouraged to submit those comments in writing prior to the meeting by emailing the City Clerk at jlindgren@elkgrovecity.org. Comments received prior to the meeting will be provided to the full Council and staff, and posted on the City website.

Comments may also be submitted in mp3 format (audio) prior to the meeting by emailing such format to the Clerk at jlindgren@elkgrovecity.org. Alternatively, comments may be provided by leaving a voicemail with the Clerk at 916-478-2286. These comments will be played back during the public comment period for a particular agenda item.

During the meeting, members of the public may provide general comments or comments on a particular agendized matter (at or before the time the item is called) by emailing the Clerk at jlindgren@elkgrovecity.org. These comments will be read aloud so the Council has the benefit of the comment when considering the matter.

Alternatively, if you wish to provide oral comments during the meeting, you may provide your phone number to the Clerk (via email) at jlindgren@elkgrovecity.org with a request to speak during General Public Comment or on a particular agendized matter. At the time the item is called, the Clerk will call the number provided and place the call on speaker so comments may be heard by anyone participating in the meeting.

The three-minute limit will be strictly observed for all oral comments submitted prior to the meeting, and for oral comments made via telephone during the meeting. Each commenter may provide one three-minute comment per item.
